

KIDS' CONTRACT

I PROMISE TO DO THE FOLLOWING:

- Before I go anywhere, I WILL get permission from my parents or the person in charge and tell them where I am going, how I will get there, who will be going with me, and when I'll be back.
- I WILL check first before changing plans or accepting money or gifts.
- I will only get in someone's vehicle- even someone I know, after calling my parents/guardian from their cell.
- I WILL say NO if someone tries to touch me in ways that make me feel frightened or uncomfortable. Then I'll tell an adult I trust.
- I will not trust anyone that offers me something to go anywhere with them or get into their car.
- I will get the description of any person and/or vehicle that tries to trick or hurt me or my friends and I WILL notify someone and call 911.
- I promise to notify my parents/guardian of all my friends and associates & their contact information.

My rules are:

- CHECK FIRST WITH ADULTS
- USE THE "BUDDY SYSTEM"
- SAY NO, THEN GO AND TELL
- LISTEN TO MY FEELINGS, AND TALK WITH ADULTS I TRUST.
- I WILL NOTIFY SOMEONE & CALL 911 IF IN DANGER.

PARENTS'/GUARDIANS' CONTRACT

I PROMISE TO DO THE FOLLOWING:

- Research carefully and recommend to my children a number of adults that they may rely on in my absence in certain circumstances.
- To do my best, to insure safe passage of my children from one environment to another.
- Before you go anywhere, I must give you permission and tell you where I to go, how you will get there, who will go with you, and when you should be back.
- If I cannot make it, I will ensure to inform you of who will pick you up and at what time.
- I promise to be vigilant and that you call from the driver's cell.
- If someone tries to touch you in ways that make you feel frightened or uncomfortable you can talk to me and I will investigate carefully.
- I will provide you with contact information and names of at least 3 adults whom you may contact in the case of emergencies.

I promise to be vigilant on a daily basis, especially in the following areas:

- YOUR ATTIRE (DRESS)
- YOUR FRIENDS & ASSOCIATES
- ADULTS I ALLOW AROUND YOU
- SAFE HOUSES I DESIGNATE FOR YOU

Guidelines for Issuing JASMINE Alerts

- ✓ There is reasonable belief by law enforcement that an abduction/kidnapping has occurred.
- ✓ The law enforcement agency believes that the child is in imminent danger of serious bodily injury or death.
- ✓ There is enough descriptive information about the victim and the abduction/kidnapping for law enforcement to issue a Jasmine Alert to assist in the recovery of the child.
- ✓ The abduction/kidnapping is of a child aged 17 years or younger.
- ✓ The child's name and other critical data elements, including the Child Abduction/kidnapping flag, have been entered into the National Crime Information Center (SIMS) system.

The Jasmine Alert is modeled off the successful Amber Alert Program of the USA. It was established in memory of Jasmine Lowe of Santa Elena Town who was abducted/kidnapped and brutally murdered in June of 2012 in the Cayo District of Belize.

This program was launched on 31 July 2012, by [BelizeCan Patriots](#). The newly formed Jasmine Alert Team, in conjunction with the Belize Police Department's Community Policing Unit now operates this program from Belmopan.

The JASMINE Alert™ Program is a voluntary partnership between law-enforcement agencies, broadcasters, transportation agencies, and the wireless industry; to activate an urgent bulletin in the most serious child-abduction/kidnapping cases. The goal of a JASMINE Alert is to instantly galvanize the entire community to assist in the search for and the safe recovery of the child.

It has been rightfully said that one ounce of prevention is better than one pound of cure! With this philosophy in mind, The Jasmine Alert Program has embarked on the monumental PREVENTION task of Educating the Populous with a safety message and a Responsibility contract.
